- 1. SREDA, Power Division, Ministry of Power, Energy & Mineral Resources has a budget allocation for the purchase of goods, services and wishes to apply some of that allocation for the purchase of goods, services for which this Request for Quotation is issued.
- Detailed Specifications and Requirement for the intended Goods and related services shall be available
 in the office of the Procuring Entity for inspection by the potential Quotationers during office hours on
 all working days.
- Quotation shall be prepared and submitted using the Quotation Document'.
- 4. Quotation shall be completed properly, duly signed-dated each page by the authorized signatory and submitted by the date of the office as specified in **Para-6** below.
- Quotation in a sealed envelope shall be submitted to the office of the undersigned on or before 12:00 PM, 17 January, 2022. The envelope containing the Quotation must be clearly marked "Quotation For Develop And Supply of Real-Time Clock (RTC) Based Centralized Solar Street Light/Led Street Light Controller" and DO NOT OPEN before 12:30 PM, 17 January 2022." Quotations received later than the time specified herein shall not be accepted.
- 6. The Procuring Entity may extend the deadline for submission of Quotations on justifiably acceptable grounds duly recorded subject to threshold of 10 (ten) days pursuant to Rule 71 (4) of the public procurement Rules, 2008.
- 7. All Quotations must be valid for a period of at least 30 days from the closing date of the Quotation.
- 8. No public opening of Quotations received by the closing date shall be held.
- Quotationer's rates or prices shall be inclusive of profit and overhead and, all kinds of tax, duties, fees, levies, and other charges to be paid under the Applicable Law, if the Contract is awarded.
- Rates shall be Quotationed and, subsequent payments under this contract shall be made in Taka currency. The price offered by the Quotationer, if accepted shall remain fixed for the duration of the Contract.



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- 11. Quotationer shall have legal capacity to enter into Contract, in support of its qualification shall be required to submit certified photocopies of latest documents related to valid **Trade License and Tax Identification Number (TIN)** without which the Quotation may be considered non-responsive.
- 12. Quotations shall be evaluated based on Total Price and documents submitted with the Quotations, by the Evaluation Committee and, at least 3 (three) responsive Quotations will be required to determine the lowest evaluated responsive Quotations for award of the Contract.
- 13. In case of discrepancy between words and figures the former will govern. Quotationer shall issuing bound to accept the arithmetic corrections made by Evaluation Committee.
- 14. The supply of Goods and related services shall be completed within 7 days from the date of issuing the Purchase Order.
- 16. The Purchase Order constitutes the Contract binding upon the Supplier and the Procuring Entity shall be issued within 5 days of receipt of approval from the Approving Authority.
- 17. The Procuring Entity reserves the right to reject all the Quotations or annul the procurement proceedings.

Specification of Develop and Supply of Real-Time Clock (RTC) Based Centralized Solar Street Light/LED Street Light Controller:

Objective:

Develop a device as attachment of Solar Street lights/LED street light with calculated sunrise and sunset time from Latitude and Longitude of the location. This device will be attached with the Street light to control its on off based on location, sun rise, sunset and date of the year.

Required Skills:

- 1. Quotationer/person appointed by quotationer should have practical knowledge on micro-controller programming (PIC, AVR etc.)
- 2. Quotationer/person appointed by quotationer should have experience on working electronic circuit design, PCB Design, Soldering, electrical know how, developing small projects.

Steps of work:

- 1. Develop controller circuit
- 2. Develop mathematical model for calculation of sun rise and sunset according to the days of the year
- 3. Develop Micro Controller program to run
- 4. Develop PCB layout, project box and get it printed (5 copy should be required)
- 5. Procure required parts, some of them are- capacitors, resistors, transistors, RTCs, Integrated circuits (ICs), Displays (7 Segments or others), electronic buttons, relays(SSR or Magnetic), Street lights (25W or more), Solar Panel (25W or more), Steel Pipes for support etc. This list will be not limited.
- 6. Develop a model street light and controller arrangement for showcasing the product (2(two) sets).
- 7. Submit Demonstrate the model to SREDA and bring required change after SREDA's comments

- Terms and Conditions contained herein shall be binding upon both the Procuring Entity and the Supplier for the 1. purpose of administration and management of this Contract.
- Implementation and interpretation of these Terms and Conditions shall, in general, be under the purview of the 2. Public Procurement Act, 2006 and the Public Procurement Rules, 2008.
- The Supplier shall have to complete the delivery in all respects within Specified time according to the 3. instruction of the purchaser after issuing the Purchase Order in conformity with the Terms and Conditions.
- The Supplier shall be entitled to an extension of the Delivery Schedule if the Procuring Entity delays in receiving 4. the Goods and related services or if Force Majeure situation occurs or for any other reasons acceptable to the Procuring Entity on justifiable grounds duly recorded.
- All delivery under the Contract shall at all times be open to examination, inspection, measurements, testing, 5. commissioning, and supervision of the Procuring Entity or his/her authorized representative.
- The Procuring Entity shall check and verify the delivery made by the Supplier in conformity with the Technical 6. Specifications and notify the Supplier of any Defects found.
- If the Goods are found to be defective or otherwise not in accordance with the specifications, the Procuring Entity 7. may reject the supplies by giving due notice to the Supplier, with reasons.
- The Supplier shall be entirely responsible for payment of all taxes, duties, fees, and such other levies under the 8. Applicable Law.
- Notwithstanding any other practice, the payment shall be based on the actual delivery of goods on the basis of the 9. quantity of each item of Goods in accordance with the Priced Schedule and Specifications. 100% of the Contract price of the Goods and related services shall be paid after submission and acceptance of the Delivery Chalan.

 - a. fails to deliver Goods and related services as per Delivery Schedule and Specifications.
 - in the judgement of the Procuring Entity, has engaged in any corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices in competing for or in delivery of goods and related services.
 - Fails to perform any other obligation(s) under the Contract.
- The Procuring Entity and the Supplier shall use their best efforts to settle amicably all possible disputes arising out of or in connection with this Contract or its interpretation.
- The Supplier shall be subject to, and aware of provision on corruption, fraudulence, collusion and coercion in Section 64 of the Public Procurement Act, 2006 and Rule 127 of the Public Procurement Rules, 2008. 20.

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
